She has successfully trained and titled her Border Collies in both Agility and Jumping including winning the Novice Dog of the Year in 2019 with *Storm*.

PROGRAM

SESSION 1: AGILITY FOR BEGINNERS

Saturday 8:30am - 10:30amWorking Spot: \$80.00 (max 8)

Participants will learn the fundamental skills needed to introduce their dog to the exciting world of agility. The session focuses on building clear communication, strengthening the bond between dog and handler, and developing essential focus skills. By the end, both dog and owner will have a solid foundation to continue in the sport, whether for fun or future competition.

SESSION 2: NOVICE AGILITY SKILLS

Saturday 11:00am - 1:30pmWorking Spot: \$100.00 (max 6)

Audit: \$20.00 (unlimited)

Participants will learn front cross, rear cross and blind cross core handling techniques needed for navigating an agility course. Emphasis is placed on developing communication between dog and handler through clear cues and timing as well as confidence-building exercises to prepare for higher levels of competition or recreational agility.

SESSION 3: FOCUSED HANDLING SKILLS

Participants learn advanced handling techniques, timing and positioning to clearly communicate with their dog on course. By refining these skills, participants build smoother, more efficient runs and strengthen the clarity and responsiveness of the dog-handler partnership.

Completion of Session 2 and/or 3 is a pre-requisite for this session.

Participants will the apply techniques learned in Session 2 or 3 to perfect their timing, precision, and communication with their dogs on the course. Challenges will be broken to enable handlers to gain a deeper understanding of body language cues, obstacle approaches, and effective reward strategies to build confidence and consistency in both dog and handler.
